

Cookies Policy

Our website www.syngentafoundation.org uses “Cookies”, as almost all websites do. Our aim is to help provide you with the best user experience that we can.

What are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files which a website may install on your computer or mobile device when you first visit a site or page. A Cookie will help the website, or another website, to recognize your device the next time you visit. “Web beacons” or other similar files can also do the same thing. We use the term “Cookies” in this policy to refer to all files that collect information in this way.

Cookies serve many functions. For example, they help us to remember your preferences, analyze how well our website is performing, or allow us to recommend content we believe will be relevant to you.

Certain Cookies contain Personal Information – for example, if you click to “remember me” when logging in, a cookie will store your username.

The Cookies used by www.syngentafoundation.org:

- won't collect information that personally identifies you
- will collect more general information such as how users arrive at and use our websites, or a user's general location.
- will not be used to give information to third-party marketing companies or media advertisers.

The Cookies we typically use are as follows:

Cookie Name	Description
_ga	Distinguishes visitors. (GA - Universal Analytics)
_gat	Throttles request rate. (GA - Universal Analytics)
#lang	Language Cookie
ASP.NET_SessionId	Identifies the visitor session on the server. Created the first time a visitor's browser accesses this site.
AWSELB	A Cookie persisted by an Elastic Load Balancer, for managing sticky sessions across production servers.

You can block Cookies by activating the setting on your browser that allows you to refuse the setting of all or some Cookies. However, if you use your browser settings to block all Cookies (including essential cookies) you may not be able to access all or parts of our site.
